COACHES, &c.

A STAGE from the Bugle Inn, every Morning at nine o'Clock, to the Vine Inn at Cowes, and returns about Noon; fets out again at two o'Clock, and returns in the Evening.

Another STAGE from Mr. Simms, the Fountain Inn, in Cowes, to the Sun Inn, in Newport, about Noon, and returns at two o'Clock in the Afternoon ; fets out again from Cowes in the Evening, and returns the fame Night.
